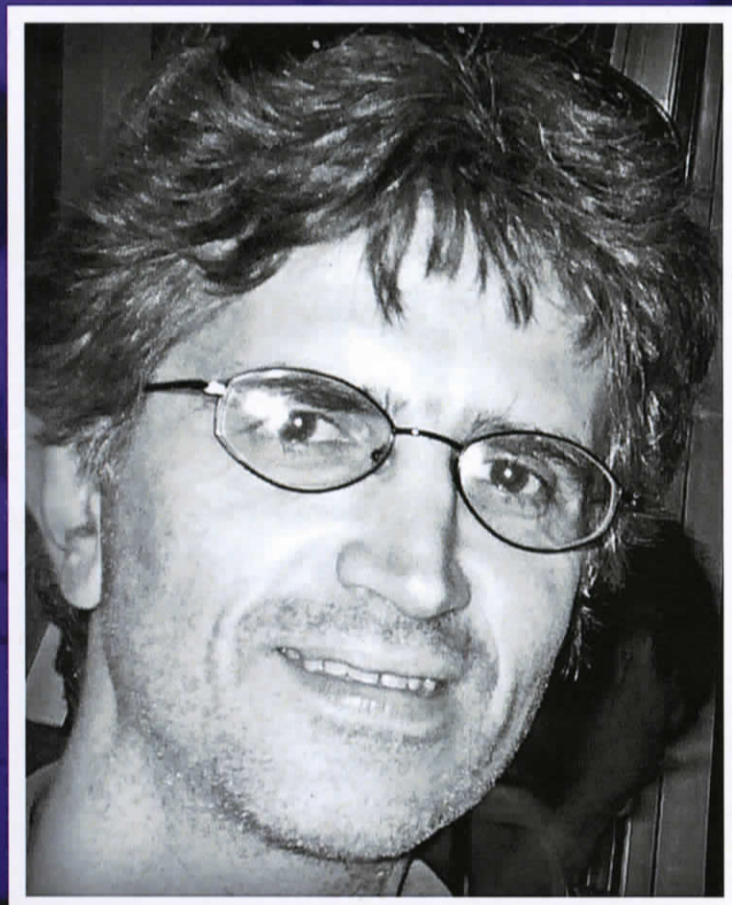


# TCI Reading Series presents:

Nicole Markotić is a Canadian poet, critic, and novelist who teaches English Literature, Creative Writing, and Disability Studies at the University of Windsor. Markotić has published two books of poetry, **Connect the Dots and Minotaurs & Other Alphabets** (Wolsak & Wynn), and two novels, **Yellow Pages** (Red Deer Press) and **Scrapbook of My Years as a Zealot** (Arsenal Press), in addition to numerous small-press publications. Her chapbook, **More Excess**, won the 1998 bpNichol Poetry Chapbook Award.

Louis Cabri teaches in the BA and MA programs in literature, creative writing, and language at the University of Windsor. His recent poetry books are **Poetryworld** (CUE) and the chapbooks **Poems** (Olive) and **—that can't** (Nomados). His books include an online edition of **The Mood Embosser** designed by Damian Lopes for Coach House Books, a book that won the Small Press Traffic Literary Arts Center (San Francisco) Book of the Year Award.
